Similar

- Both are enterprise content management systems.
- Both are part of CMS Focus

Different

- Tiki is community open source while Magnolia is single-vendor commercial open source. Thus, Magnolia has a "community" version and an "enterprise" version.
 - Most of the committers here work for Magnolia, whereas in Tiki contributions come from various organizations
- Alfresco is written in Java whereas Tiki is written in PHP.
- Tiki hosting requirements are easier (shared hosting)
- Tiki dogfoods its own wiki where as Magnolia uses Confluence, a commercial wiki engine
- Tiki has more built-in features, well, because Tiki is the FLOSS Web Application with the most built-in features
 - In Tiki, you get all these features built-in and as Open Source, whereas in Magnolia, some features you could want, like a Mobile version, "you need a Enterprise Edition of Magnolia"
