

Tiki vs Xoops

Similar

- Both are full-featured free and open source web applications with which you can realize a very diverse variety of projects.
- Both are written in PHP and use a database such as MySQL
- Both can run on standard, inexpensive hosting.
- Both have large & vibrant communities
- Both use the Smarty template engine.

Different

- Tiki is more centralized. Tiki is the [all-in-one model](#) while Xoops (like [Joomla!](#)) is the small-core-and-add-what-you-need model. Each model has its pros & cons.
- Tiki is Wiki-centric. Please see (if) [Why Wiki Syntax Is Important](#) to your project.
- Xoops is GPL, Tiki is LGPL. [The main difference between the GPL and the LGPL is that the latter can be linked to \(in the case of a library, 'used by'\) a non-\(L\)GPLed program, which may be free software or proprietary software.](#)
